We all laughed and the owner took him home.



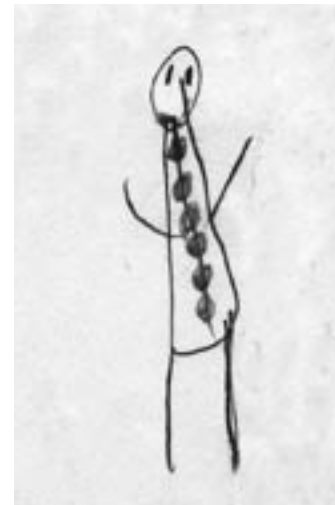
Emily Tindol 2nd
